

San Jose Sports Authority will wrap up 3rd Olympic Trials with another big crowd

SAN JOSE, Calif. – (June 14, 2004) – The San Jose Sports Authority wraps up a trio of popular Olympic qualifying events on Saturday when it hosts the U.S. Olympic Team Trials in Rhythmic Gymnastics and Trampoline at the San Jose State University Event Center. Attendance for the event is forecast at 2,500. Nearly 1,700 tickets have already been distributed.

One athlete in each discipline will win a berth on the U.S. Olympic Team from a field of 13 candidates in Saturday's 6 p.m. trials at the San Jose State University Event Center. The field for the trials was set at the Visa U.S. Championships earlier this month in Nashville, Tenn.

In May the Sports Authority hosted the U.S. Trials for the Wheelchair Track Olympic Exhibition as part of the Far West Games, a non-ticketed competition. On June 5, the two competition sessions of the U.S. Olympic Team Trials in Judo and Taekwondo drew more than 6,500 fans to the Event Center.

The U.S. Olympic Team Trials are among more than 120 sports events brought to the city by the San Jose Sports Authority.
