**SAN JOSE (Feb. 17, 2005)** – Registration forms The First Tee® of San Jose's spring session of golf instruction for youngsters are now available for downloading and printing from the San Jose Sports Authority's web site at [www.sjsa.org](http://www.sjsa.org).

Formerly known as the Eagles at Rancho del Pueblo, the instructional program offering free course access and lessons has grown to become most popular of the Sports Authority's community programs, introducing more than 600 kids to the game of golf and the life skills it teaches since its inception in 2001.

The First Tee® of San Jose is open to boys and girls ages 10 to 14. The program at Rancho del Pueblo Golf Course at 1649 Hermocilla Way:

- Includes 32 hours of PGA and LPGA instruction, equipment and snacks, all free of charge.
- Offers graduates Continued Access Privileges at Rancho del Pueblo that include one free bucket of balls each day plus additional buckets at \$1 each, or a nine-hole round of golf.

The mission of the The First Tee® of San Jose is to provide young people of all backgrounds an opportunity to develop, through golf and character education, life-enhancing values such as honesty, integrity and sportsmanship. The intent is to offer opportunities for improvement in the quality of life and create a platform where children can increase their potential for success.

To register, parents must complete either the [English](#) or [Spanish](#) PDF form from the web site and bring it to registration at Rancho del Pueblo at 9 a.m. Saturday, March 5. Forms are also available at the course's pro shop. Only the first 45 forms returned in person on that date will be accepted.

The First Tee of San Jose's spring session will include beginners' classes held from 3:30-5:30 p.m. Tuesdays and Thursdays beginning April 5 and ending May 26. Intermediate classes will be held from 3:30-5:30 p.m. Wednesdays from April 6 through May 11. Intermediate tryouts will be held immediately after registration.
